I'm pleased to welcome back Yvonne Felker to the Board of Directors as she resumes her role as the Recording Secretary. With the resignation of Richard L. Hinkle, Myra Wolf Hoffman has been elected to fill Rev Hinkle's seat on the board.

The Association has decided to open a safe deposit box at National Penn Bank to secure our valuable documents. The box will provide a central location and controlled access to important information.
